
Public Notice: Temporary Chlorination After Water Shut Off

To Our Water Customers:

Please be advised that **any time a water shut off occurs** in the [Name of Water System], the system will be **chlorinated when service is restored**.

This chlorination is a standard safety measure required by the **Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ)** to ensure the water remains safe to drink after service interruptions.

You may notice a **temporary chlorine smell or taste** in the water once it is turned back on. This is normal and should **work itself out of the system within 3 to 4 hours** after water service is restored.
